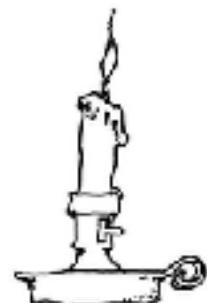
Friday 10/29 - 4-6:30pm
